Teaching Policy, School of Natural and Behavioral Sciences

Approved by NBS Chairs on April 23, 2015

In order to ensure an equitable distribution of faculty effort in teaching and also support faculty research activities and doctoral education the School of Sciences will implement the following guidelines in determining the faculty teaching assignments by the Department Chairs.

- Faculty with grants will be permitted to buy down to one organized course teaching load per semester but not below that. Under unusual circumstances at the discretion of the Chair faculty will be permitted to buy down to two organized courses per academic year with both courses taught in the same semester.
- At least half of the teaching of organized courses per academic year should be done at Brooklyn College.
- Teaching of organized courses at the Graduate Center should be limited to at most 2 courses per academic year.
